Polesden Lacey—An Edwardian Country House with beautiful gardens

We are delighted to announce that on Wednesday 7th September we will be visiting Polesden Lacey.

Just a short drive away in Dorking, Polesden Lacey is one of the National Trust's most popular properties.

There has been a house on the site since the 14th Century, the current property was extensively remodelled in 1906 by the owner, Margaret Greville, a well-know Edwardian socialite. Her collection of fine paintings, furniture, porcelain and silver is displayed in the reception rooms and galleries, as it was at the time of her celebrated house parties.

In 1923 Margaret invited the Duke and Duchess of York to spend their honeymoon at Polesden Lacey and the royal couple subsequently spent two weeks there.

The house is surrounded by beautiful countryside for members to explore. It includes two working farms, ancient woodland and rolling downland, offering a diverse range of places for wildlife to live.

There is a lovely café to cater for all our refreshment needs in addition to a shop selling local produce and a second-hand bookshop.

Hughenden—Country home of Benjamin Disraeli

On Thursday 6th October our programme continues with a visit to Hughenden, near High Wycombe.

Hughenden offers a vivid insight into the charismatic personality and colourful private life of the Victorian Prime Minister, Benjamin Disraeli, who lived here from 1848 to 1881. You can browse among an extraordinary collection of personal memorabilia in rooms on the ground and first floor. On the top floor there is a special exhibition space with a timeline of Hughenden's history for you to explore.

The formal garden has been recreated based on the original designs of Mary Anne Disraeli and there are woodland walks surrounding this country home throughout rolling parkland.

A secret wartime past is revealed in a fascinating immersive exhibition in the bunker.

There is a café on site to cater for us and a National Trust shop selling a wide variety of items.
